ANNUAL PRICE INCREASE

Greater Shepparton City Council's proposed 2017-2018 Fees and Charges are scheduled to be adopted at the Ordinary Council Meeting on 20 June 2017. If adopted the following increases will apply effective from 1 July 2017 (subject to change):

- 3.5 percent Direct Debit Memberships, Term Memberships, Casual Entry and Visit Passes;
- 5 percent Swim School, Active Kids, Community Groups.

Aquamoves' operational and maintenance costs continue to rise, increasing the expense of supplying our diverse range of facilities, services and programs. Passing on some of these costs through small fee increases is necessary and responsible management, allowing us to maintain the centre's long term viability.

Aquamoves will continue to provide one of the largest group fitness timetables in Victoria and is committed to investing in the renewal of the facility and equipment. The ongoing development of the Swim School is a key focus; ensuring resources are in place to provide the opportunity for all children to develop the essential life skill of swimming.

The Council continues to invest significant capital in Aquamoves to ensure we are providing a facility that remains at the forefront of our industry.
