Childcare Guidelines

In order to provide a safe and happy environment for your child, Aquamoves Childcare complies with Children Services Regulations. These guidelines are listed below.

- Children who are sick or who have an infectious disease can not come into care. Please check with staff if you are unsure about bringing your child.
- On arrival and departure a parent/guardian must sign their child in/out with exact times.
- If something out of the ordinary has happened to your child before arrival please advise childcare staff so we can provide some TLC.
- If your child is stressed, hurt or unwell staff will notify parents/guardians.
- A change of clothes and/or nappies is required for babies and children who are toilet training.
- Please ensure all items brought into the centre including spare clothes, food and drink containers are clearly labelled with your child's name.
- Please provide a healthy snack and a drink/ bottle (filled with water) for your child when they attend. All consumables should be clearly labelled.
- We prefer you to not include NUTS, Peanut butter or Nutella due to the associated choking/allergy risks.

We welcome all queries and suggestions. Please don't hesitate to speak to one of our friendly staff.

Cancellations

Cancellations must be made before 8.00am on the morning of your booking or the full fee will be charged.

Prior notification of cancellations is important as there may be another family waiting to use our childcare services.

Cancellations can be made any time during Aquamoves operating hours if Childcare staff are unavailable. Reception staff will take a message and pass the details on to Childcare staff.

Enrolling in Childcare

Enrolments must be completed online by visiting www.greatershepparton.com.au/childcare-kinder-enrol

A copy of your child's up-to-date AIR Immunisation History Statement will need to be uploaded as part of the application process.

Enrolment must be completed prior to your first booking.

Aquamoves Occasional Childcare can accept children aged from eight weeks up to 10 years, provided they have undergone their six week immunisation before enrolling.

Staff Qualifications

Aquamoves Childcare is run by friendly and professional staff holding either their Diploma in Childcare or their Certificate III in Childcare Studies.

Operating Hours

Aquamoves Childcare is available from Monday to Friday between 9.00am and 12.15pm. It is closed on all public holidays, for one day in May annually (for a Childcare staff conference) and during a small break over the Christmas/New Year period.

They will pass on the details of your booking to Childcare staff who will contact you to confirm your booking. Bookings open on Mondays at 8.30am for the following week.

Customer Service staff can not make confirmed bookings.
